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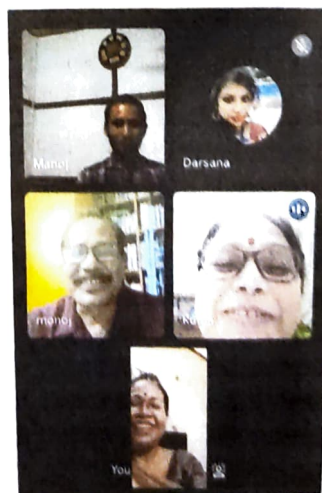
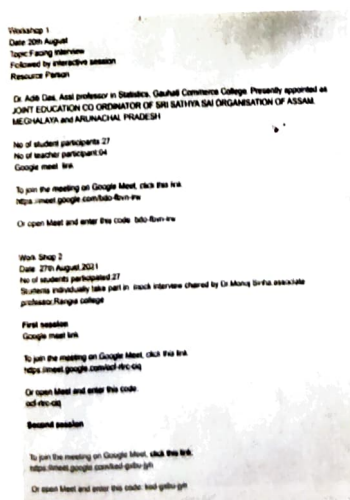

	Title: “ Critical Thinking and Philosophizing”		<p><b><u>Press Release</u></b></p> <p><b>ICPR sponsored Lecture Series in Pandu College</b></p> <p>An online lecture series titled "Critical Thinking and Philosophizing", sponsored by the Indian Council of Philosophical Research and organized by the Department of Philosophy, Pandu College, was concluded on Saturday, 8 January, 2022. The series of lectures was initiated by the renowned scholar Prof.A. Raghuramaraju, Dept. of Humanities and Social Sciences, IIT Tirupati, on 15 December, 2021, by delivering the first lecture of the series titled "Problematising two aspects in critical thinking". In his lecture, Prof.Raghuramaraju illustrated numerous instances of one philosopher criticizing the ideas and thoughts of other philosophers in the history of philosophy, and how this process of criticism through revelations brought freshness to thinking and accomplishes creativity to beliefs.</p> <p>The second lecture titled "Moral dilemma in Mahabharata" was delivered by Prof. Nava Kumar Handique, Former Dean and Professor, Dibrugarh University on 28 December, 2021. Analysing several characters in the epic Mahabharata in depth, Prof. Handique demonstrated how the persons with ethical values undergo moral dilemma.</p> <p>The third and concluding lecture titled "Philosophizing the meaning of meaning" was delivered by Dr. Shivani Sharma, Dept. of Philosophy, Panjab University, Chandigarh on 8 January, 2022. Speaking on Philosophy of language and meaning in the context of ancient Indian Philosophy, Dr. Sharma analysed different aspects of Sabda-Pramana.</p> <p>More than hundred teachers, research scholars and students from different parts of the country joined and participated actively in the lecture series. Each of the lectures was followed by vibrant discussions and interactions between the speakers and the participants. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Jogesh Kakati, Principal, Pandu College, and coordinated by Dr. Maitreyee, Head, Department of Philosophy, Pandu College.</p>

Description:


