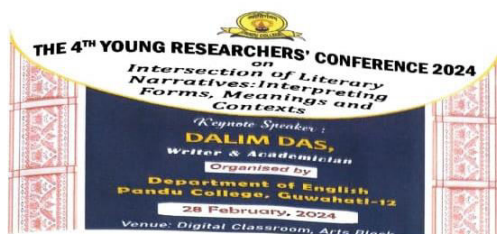

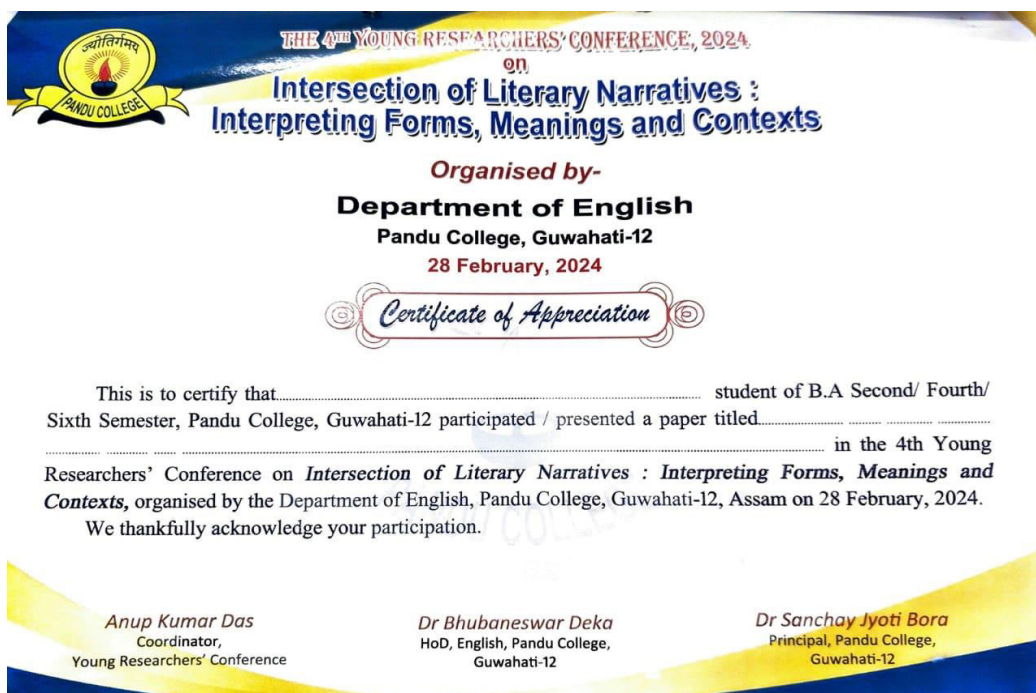
Report:
