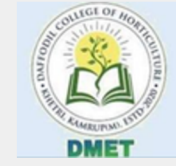

- A student in the SCIENCE stream must opt at least one subject from Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

*Note that from Economics, Geography, Computer Science & Application and Entrepreneurship Development, a student can opt for only ONE subject.

In addition to the compulsory subjects in Group A, one student can opt any **THREE** subjects from Group B and any one subject from Group C.

Note that

(i) Note that from Geography, Computer Science & Application, Sanskrit and Entrepreneurship Development, Advance Bodo, a student can opt only **ONE** subject.

(ii) Note that from History and Mathematics, a student can opt only **ONE** subject.

(iii) Advance Bodo is open for only to those students who do not opt Bodo as MIL.

If the student opts for THREE subjects from Group B, then he/she has to select any one subject from Group C. A student in the COMMERCE stream must opt for the subjects Accountancy and Business Studies from Group B. Note that

*From Business Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science & Application and Entrepreneurship Development, a student can opt for only ONE subject.

GENERAL ADMISSION RULES

ELIGIBILITY

Higher Secondary (HS): A candidate must pass HSLC examination from the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) (earlier Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA)) or equivalent examination recognized by ASSEB.

PROCEDURE

The admission to Higher Secondary (Science/Arts/Commerce) 1st year will be conducted via the common Admission Portal of ASSEB www.darpan.ahseconline.in as per government notification.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Application Form for admission to various courses is to be submitted through online mode in the prescribed form within a specific date as notified in advance.
2. The merit lists will be displayed on the College Notice Board/ Website, well ahead of the admission date.
3. Admission will be held in offline mode in the college as per the dates of admission to be notified in due course.
4. A student has to upload the self-attested copies of the following documents at the time of online form submission. The same documents in the original have to be produced at the time of physical verification.

- HSLC admit card/certificate for proof of age.
- HSLC mark sheet.
- Original mark sheet of the last examination passed.
- Original certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- Gap certificate (in case the student has passed the qualifying exam earlier).

NB: The gap certificate must be issued by the Head of the Educational Institution last studied/ Gazetted officer/registered medical practitioner)

- Caste certificate (in case of SC/ ST/ OBC/ MOBC/EWS).
- Migration / Transfer certificate, as the case may be.
- Certificate of proficiency in co-curricular activities, as the case may be.
- Parents' Income Certificate (For Free Admission).
- Certificate of domicile of Assam (as per any document specified by the Govt.).

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS SEEKING FREE ADMISSION

- The selection under the free admission category will be strictly as per the Government rules.
- A student is eligible for free admission in only one institution.
- College authority reserves the right to free admission, and the decision of the authority will be final.

CANDIDATES SEEKING FREE ADMISSION SHALL HAVE TO PRODUCE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN ORIGINAL AT THE TIME OF VERIFICATION

- Mark sheet of the last qualifying examination
- Age Certificate/HSLC Admit Card
- Character Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended
- Caste Certificate, wherever necessary (issued by the competent authority under the Government of Assam shall be the only valid)
- PWD Certificate wherever necessary (issued by the competent authority)
- Migration Certificate (for students migrating from a Board/Council/University other than AHSEC/G.U.) with a photocopy of the same.
- Gap Certificate (for candidates who have passed their qualifying examination earlier than the current year).
- An undertaking from the applicant and his/her parent/guardian in the prescribed ANTI-RAGGING form.
- All downloaded mark sheets will have to be attested by the Head of the Institution last attended.

RESERVATION RULES

There is a provision for reservation of seats, as per the Government of Assam rules for the candidates belonging to the State of Assam. In this respect, caste certificate issued by the competent authority under Government of Assam only shall be valid.
